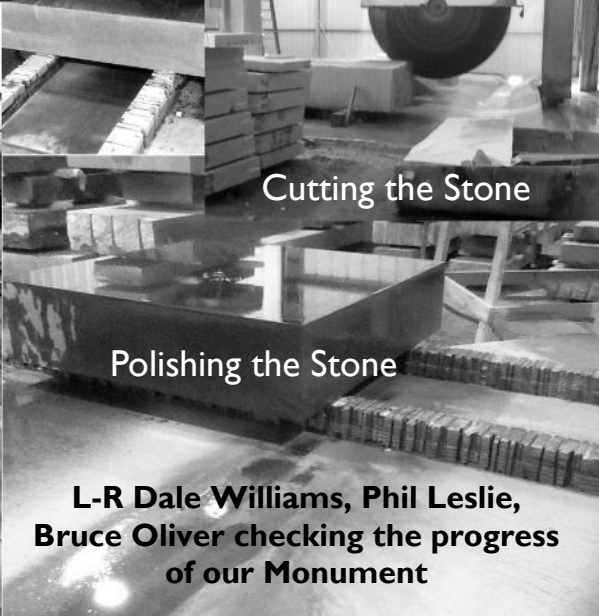

Rear Right - Origin of Ghost Battalion

Initially, units of the battalion conducted heliborne raids into enemy held areas. Because these assault units would suddenly appear, then disappear only to reappear in a different location, the enemy radio operators referred to the battalion as “Ghosts”.

During May 1968 while operating in the Khe Sanh area, the battalion out maneuvered elements of the North Vietnamese Army. When the NVA Commander informed his HQ Command that he lost contact with the battalion. he was relieved of his command. The intercepted NVA message traffic referred to 2d Battalion, 1st Marines as a “Ghost Battalion”.

Engraved Memorial Bricks

A double row of Engraved Memorial Bricks line the pathways of the Semper Fidelis Memorial Park, National Museum of the Marine Corps, Quantico, VA. Each engraved brick honors the donor or another person. Bricks may be ordered through Vietnam Veterans 2/1 or through the Marine Corps Heritage Foundation [MCHF]. Each brick costs \$300 and you may order as many as you like. **There is no guarantee that orders received will be inscribed and placed by Nov 8th. Please Note: There is no guarantee of where your memorial brick will be placed if ordered thru MCHF except it will be 'somewhere' along the pathways in the order received. However, if your engraved brick is ordered through V V 2/1, it will be placed at or adjacent to the V V 2/1 Memorial Monument.** *** Bricks ordered must be paid in full at the time of the order *** Each person ordering an engraved brick will receive a special Certificate of Registration recognizing their contribution and confirming the Inscription(s) submitted.

Engraving is limited to 3 lines of 20 characters each. A character includes all letters, punctuations and spaces. Each line must end with a full word or name (words and names will not be hyphenated and continued on the next line.)
